Earls went on to say, "this is from the ARPA dollars which clarifies the Miami Tribe could spend their monies for safety issues and they identified the Ottawa County Jail as a major safety issue, so they are transferring 2 million dollars to the County to infuse into jail repairs. We don't know what we would have done without this donation. The roof alone will cost around 1 million. And the locks, doors, plumbing, and electrical will cost in the neighborhood of 2 million. Our partnerships with the tribes are "the best of the best" and we are so thankful for those partnerships. A huge thank you to the Miami Nation and Chief Lankford for their forward thinking and their infusion of dollars into the County Jail.
