D. Total number of people benefiting from project: All students that are enrolled Pre K thru the 12th grade will have access to this facility. The main purpose will be for athletics and physical education classes. This is approximately 700 students. Also this facility would be used by the people of the community for exercise. This facility would also be used by the city youth football, baseball and softball teams. There are approximately 35 children who play city league football. That number increases for city baseball teams (boys 90), and city softball teams (girls 60). At this time we open up the old gym for the community to use for exercise but this facility would allow us to let the community have access to a bigger facility.

G. Brief explanation of the local effort in project: Extensive preparations to the property, such as clearing of tress and getting the ground ready for foundation. There have been many parents and local businessman who have helped with various projects at the school. They have all expressed interest in helping in this project if the grant proposal is accepted. These volunteers would help with the cleaning of the property, plumbing, and the construction of the building.
